## **BINGO:**

This fundraiser is not only our longest running fundraiser of 11 years, but it is also our most successful. Cardinal Soccer Club Bingo is held at the American Legion Post 72 building in Mt. Carmel. The hours are from 5:30-10:00 pm. GSE Cardinal Bingo is held every Monday; weather permitting, except for Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Years Eve and New Years Day. Bingo has been very beneficial to our soccer club. We have earned over \$1,000,000 in revenue during our 11 years. This is how we were able to pay cash for the Amelia Soccer Training Complex and develop it to its high standards. As a current Cardinal parent you are benefiting from previous parents' hard work. We need to keep the tradition going by supporting bingo. You can support bingo by volunteering when your team is scheduled.

## **TEAM ASSIGNMENTS:**

Teams are required to supply volunteers to help staff bingo, and in return, the volunteers are able to reduce their individual club fees. Teams are normally assigned one bingo rotation (two consecutive Monday nights) each year. Assignments are distributed to coaches in January and July. By volunteering you will be reducing your individual club fees and allowing the club to raise money to be able to make future capital improvements to the training center.

Your team coach/treasurer or parent administrator will be contacted either by e-mail or phone to be given the dates that have been assigned to your team. It is a good idea for your team to have one parent volunteer as the "bingo captain" who will organize your volunteers. When your team has been assigned dates, the bingo captain is responsible for signing up 6 to 7 volunteers from your team. Volunteers will be selling "pull tab" tickets.

Arrival time: 4 @ 5:30 and 3 @ 6:00. It is critical that volunteers be on time because the early time before bingo actually begins is our most productive time in pull tab sales. Each volunteer will sign in, put on a red vest which designates you as a bingo pull tab seller, and obtain more instructions from the Office Manager. Remember that each time you work bingo it has a direct impact on you by reducing your individual club fees. Please make every effort to work when your team has been assigned.
